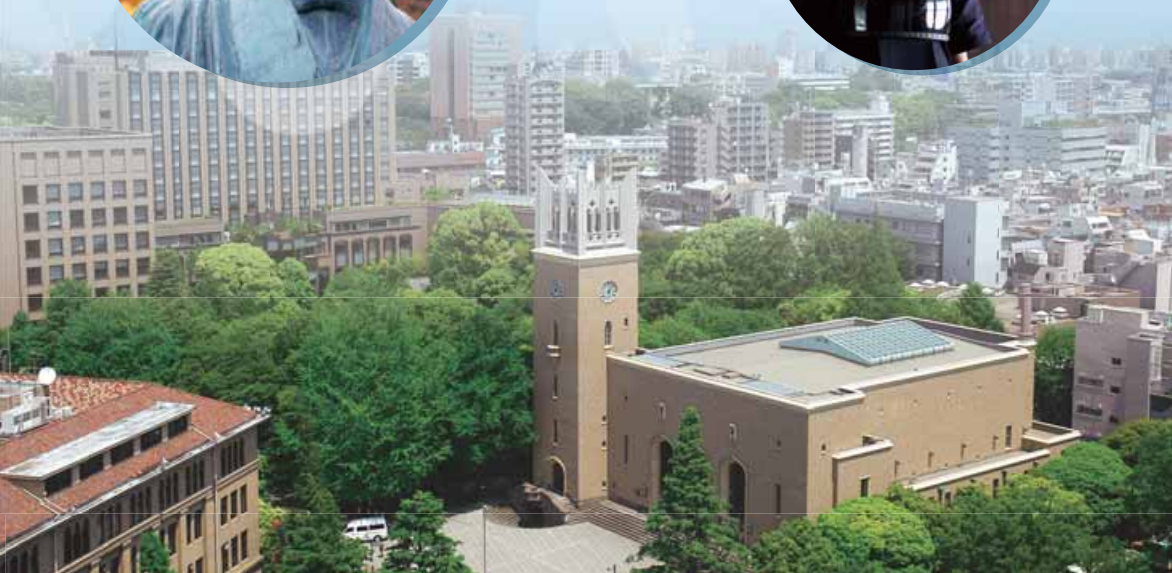


WASEDA University

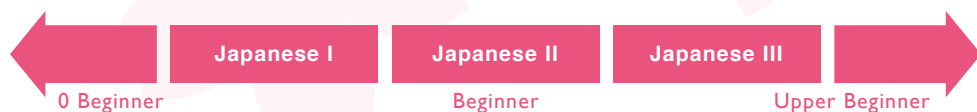

# Director's Voice

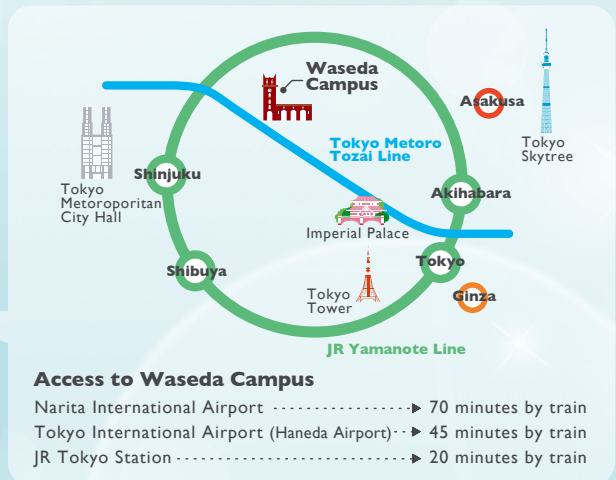
