

中正大学 2014 ISS (International Summer School) 以「全球社会与多元文化」为主轴，其规划理念如下：

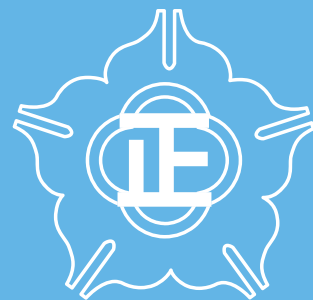
1. 中正 ISS 课程与活动均以「全球社会与多元文化」为主轴，适合各种转业背景的学生一起选修，除分享并增进跨领域知识外，并有效提升多元国际视野。
2. 本课程内容包括生命哲学、教育、法律人权、环保、专业伦理、地方人文及语言等，每门课程均配合社会学习及文化参访活动，强调团队学习、互动教学及做中学。
3. 为了能增进学习效果，中正 ISS 还设计课程互访、专题成果发表会、国际习俗体验日、校园寻宝及体育竞赛等活动，透过实质交流建立情谊，进而经营跨国知识分享网路。

글로벌 사회와 다원적 (多元的) 문화”를 주제로 하는 중정대학 (中正大學) 의 2014 년도 국제여름학교 (International Summer School, ISS) 는 다음과 같은 특색이 있습니다.

1. 중정 ISS 과정과 활동은 “글로벌 사회의 다원적 문화”를 기반으로 있으므로 다양한 전공 분야의 학생들이 참여할 수 있으며, 본 프로그램을 통해 학생들은 다양한 학문 영역의 지식을 습득하고 국제적 감각을 함양할 수 있습니다.
2. 본 과정은 생명철학, 교육, 인권법, 환경보호, 직업윤리, 지역문화와 언어 등에 관한 내용을 포함합니다. 각 수업에서는 사회적 체험과 문화 활동을 할 수 있으며, 협동학습, 상호작용적 학습 및 체험학습이 강조될 것입니다.
3. 보다 효율적인 학습을 위해 중정 ISS 과정은 현장학습, 프로젝트 성과 발표회, 국제문화의 날 행사, 교내 보물찾기, 체육 경기 등 우정을 쌓을 수 있는 다양한 이벤트를 계획하고 있습니다. 이러한 다양한 활동을 통해 공고한 국제적 지식 공유 네트워크를 형성하기를 기대합니다.

Die ISS 2014 [International Summer School 2014] der Chung Cheng University hat als Thema „Globale und multikulturellen Gesellschaft“, wobei sich das Planungskonzept für den Kurs wie folgt gestaltet:

1. Die Programmpunkte und Aktivitäten folgen der thematischen Achse des Themas „Globale und multikulturelle Gesellschaft“, was sich für Studenten verschiedener Fachbereiche eignet. Neben dem Austausch von Wissen und der Vertiefung der interdisziplinärer Fähigkeiten wird eine effektive Erweiterung einer vielfältigen internationalen Perspektive geboten.
2. Der Kurs umfasst Philosophie des Lebens, Bildung, Menschenrechte, Umweltschutz, Berufsethik, lokale Kulturen sowie Sprachen. Dabei ist jeder Kurs mit sozialkundlichem Lernen und kulturellen Besuchsaktivitäten kombiniert, betont teamorientiertes Lernen, interaktiven Unterricht sowie praktisches Lernen.
3. Um die Lerneffektivität zu erhöhen, umfasst der Programm gegenseitige Kursbesuche, thematisch orientierte Präsentationen von Ergebnissen, einen Erlebnistag für internationale Sitten, eine „Schatzsuche“ auf dem Campus sowie Sportwettbewerbe und andere Aktivitäten. Durch die substantiellen Austausch wird, die Kameradschaft aufgebaut, um so das grenzüberschreitende Wissensaustausch-Netzwerk.

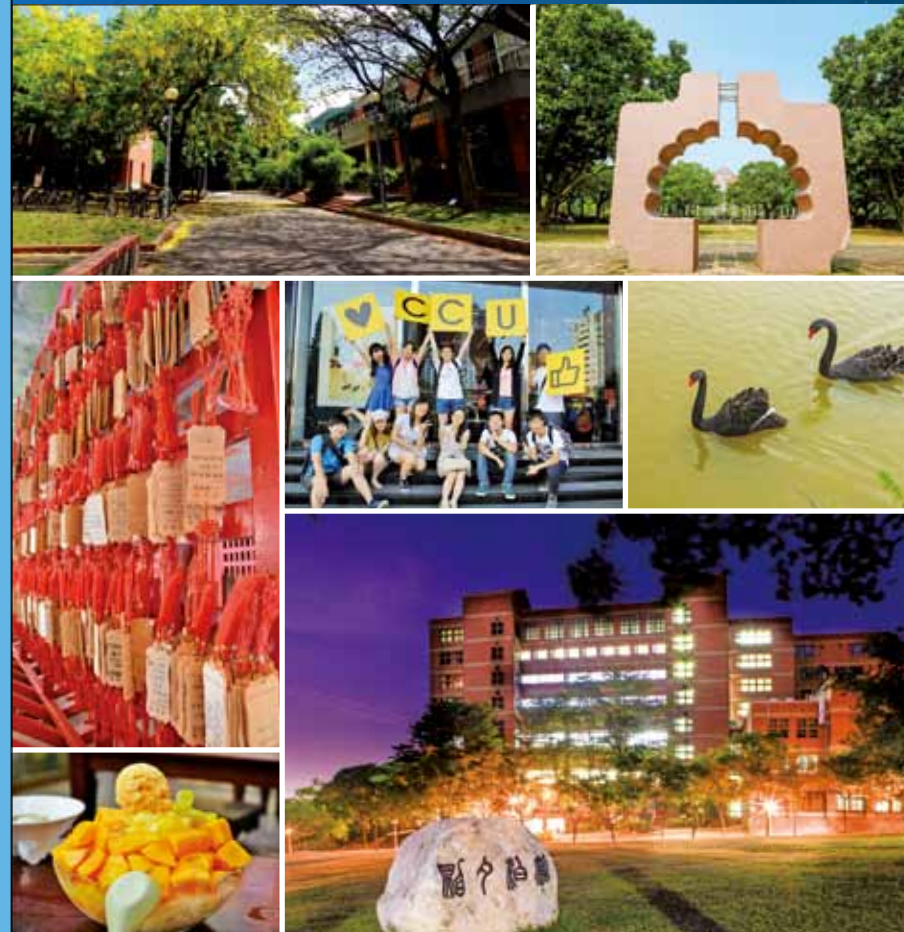

2014 年度中正大学国際サマー・スクールのテーマは、「グローバルで多元的文化の社会」です。
この国際サマー・スクールの主な特徴は、3 つです。

1. 2014 年度中正大学国際サマー・スクールが提供するすべてのコースと活動は、いずれも「グローバル社会と多元的文化」を共通のテーマにしています。そのため、様々な領域を専攻する学生が参加することができます。このプログラムを通して、学生は、学際的な知識を深め、多様な国際的な視野を身に付けることができます。
2. サマースクールが提供するコースには、生命哲学、教育、人権法、環境保護、専門職倫理、地域文化、言語などが含まれています。それぞれのコースには、社会的体験をし、文化見学をする活動が組み合わさっていて、協力学習、対話型学習、実践を通じた学習を重視しています。
3. 学習の効率を増やすために、中正国際サマー・スクールは、さらにフィールド調査、学生が学習の成果を発表するプログラム、各国習俗体験日、キャンパス宝探し、スポーツ試合などのイベントを催し、実質的な交流によって人間関係を深め、さらに国境を越えた知識を共有するネットワークを作ろうとしています。

The theme of the Chung Cheng University 2014 ISS will be “Global and Multi-cultural Society,” developed as follows:

1. Chung Cheng ISS courses and activities will revolve around the theme “Global and Multi-cultural Society,” and will be suitable for students from a variety of academic backgrounds. The program will enhance interdisciplinary knowledge and also help students cultivate a diverse international perspective.
2. The contents of the courses include philosophy of life, education, human rights legislation, environmental protection, professional ethics, local culture and language, etc. Each class will incorporate social practices and cultural activities and will emphasize cooperative learning, interactive learning and learning by doing.
3. In order to further enhance the effectiveness of learning, Chung Cheng ISS will plan field trips, a final program for students to share their insights, an international culture feast, campus treasure hunt, sports competitions and other activities to build camaraderie through shared activities, thus creating a multi-national knowledge-sharing network.
