

Terms

The academic year is divided into three terms.

- Autumn term :
from the beginning of September to the third week of December;
- Winter term :
from the first week of January to the end of April;
- Summer term :
from May to the end of June or to the end of August depending on the courses taken.

Length of studies

Most doctoral students register for three terms per year – including the summer – although in most programs courses are not offered during this period. The Ph.D. coursework takes a minimum of six terms, at the end of which students begin to write their thesis.
